- This show is curated by Miles Howard-Wilks, Sandy Fernee and Sarah Lamanna.



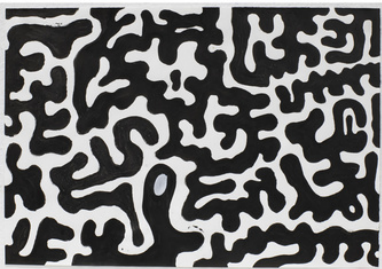

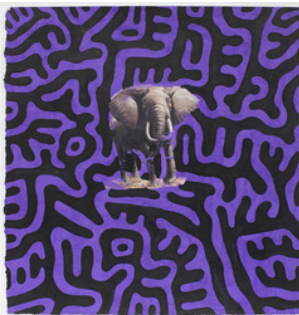

- Dionne makes art about her favourite musicians and animals.

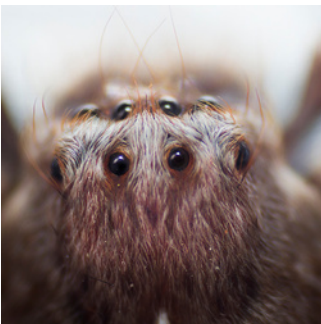

- Michael makes abstract artwork inspired by art history.

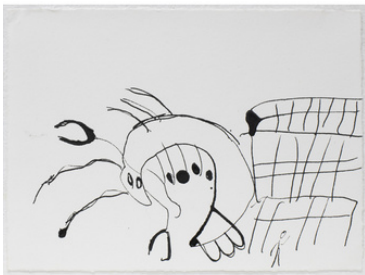

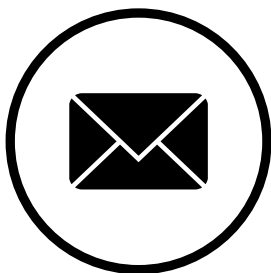
